<b>Goal of Position:</b>	To aid Carver County Historical Society staff in numbering objects from the textile collection
<b>Possible Duties:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Work with the curator to select objects from the textile collection for numbering</li> <li>- Create custom labels for each piece</li> <li>- Carefully sew label onto the original piece using approved conservation techniques</li> <li>- Storage of textiles using approved museum quality standards</li> </ul>
<b>Qualifications:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Basic sewing knowledge</li> <li>- Ability to learn new stitching techniques</li> <li>- Steady hand for neat, precise stitching</li> <li>- Ability to follow instruction</li> <li>- Attentive to detail</li> <li>- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision</li> <li>- Interest in historic clothing, quilts, and other textiles</li> <li>- Careful workmanship</li> <li>- Desire to improve museum records through correct labeling</li> </ul>
