



Challenge Grant Pledge Form

The Historic Andrew Peterson Farmstead was donated to the Carver County Historical Society in 2013. Peterson Farmstead was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1978 for Andrew Peterson's horticulture work with apple trees. His 48 year diaries were used as a primary source for Wilhelm Moberg while writing his Emigrant book series.

In 2017, the CCHS completed the restoration of the north Peterson barn. It now focuses its attention on the farmhouse.



Larger pledges (exceeding 25% of the project budget) may be subject to additional restrictions.
