We won the grant!

The year 2015 ended on a high note. Not only was closing paperwork for the farm signed, but we received word we had won a \$182,223 Legacy grant to complete the restoration of the North Peterson Barn. Put on hold for years due to the will contest, it is great to know that very soon we will be able to begin the final stage of restoration for this building.

Work will start as soon as all the paperwork is completed, around the beginning of February. You will be able to watch the progress through the warmth of your own home as a webcam will be installed, allowing viewers to watch the progress in real time. The cameras will also be monitored by the State Historic Preservation Office and a Historic Structural engineer. The public may watch it on the Andrew Peterson tab on our website. Be sure to check the website (Adult, Family and History Camp pages) and Facebook for the latest program options and availability.


